The Junior League of Waterloo-Cedar Falls is offering a scholarship opportunity to current high school female seniors.

Two \$500 scholarships will be given to two students in the AEA 267 district who demonstrate the qualities that Junior League values including: voluntarism, leadership, and academic achievement.

All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- A graduating female senior from a public or private high school in the Cedar Valley
- High school cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (B) or above
- Demonstrated commitment to voluntarism
- Citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Applicant must agree to use funds to attend an established, accredited training or educational program or for related expenses incurred while attending said program (e.g., tuition/program fees, books, supplies, transportation, child care, etc.).
- Acceptance (or a pending acceptance) to a post-secondary institution required for receipt of scholarship
- May not be an immediate (sister or daughter) relative of an active JLWCF member

Two letters of recommendation, the attached application completed by the student, and a copy of transcripts and ACT/SAT scores must be sent to Junior League by Friday, April 2, 2010. Please mail two copies of all documents together in one large envelope. The winner will be notified in April and will be recognized at Junior League's Annual Dinner in May.
